# The Way the BIC Uses Your Information:

The **BIC** will collect E-mail addresses and other personally identifiable data about visitors when such data is voluntarily submitted to us via mail or the **BIC** website. Contact information obtained from sign-up forms is used to send information and data about the **Brain Injury Connection** 

to our visitors.

The **BIC** will collect personal information from visitors in connection with voluntary surveys.

Data may be collected on the **BIC** website or through the mail. The information you provide in answer to any survey questions will be shared only in the aggregate.

All survey data is reported and/or used in aggregate form only, and no personally identifiable information is released.

The only information we collect from website visits are the name of your internet service provider, the browser and type of machine you are using, the web site that referred you to us, the pages you request and the date and time you request them. We use this information to generate statistics and measure site activity to improve the usefulness of the BIC site to our visitors.

Like most websites, the Brain Injury Connection (BIC) may place a "cookie," or small file, in the browser files of a visitor's computer. We use cookies to save information you give us so you don't have to re-enter it each time you visit our site.
